Typical Game Modes

- **Jackpot:** Multiple players deposit skins into a single pot. The higher the value of a gamer's deposit, the greater their analytical opportunity of winning the whole built up pot.
- **Esports Betting:** Wagering on expert CS2 matches (e.g., ESL Pro League, Majors) utilizing virtual balance or skins, forecasting match winners, map ratings, or specific in-game occasions.
