1. The AWP|Dragon Lore

Possibly the most famous skin in the game, the Dragon Lore features a mythical dragon breathing fire throughout the body of the sniper rifle. Originally dropped solely on specific maps like Cobblestone throughout significant tournaments, these souvenir bundles are now exceedingly uncommon. A Factory New Souvenir Dragon Lore signed by superstar player Skadoodle famously cost over £ 60,000 years ago, and costs have only intensified considering that.

2. The AK-47|Case Hardened (Pattern 661 "Blue Gem")

While a basic Case Hardened AK-47 is relatively inexpensive, the top-tier pattern indices-- specifically Pattern 661-- cover almost the whole leading receiver of the weapon in a beautiful, reflective blue.
