A chain-drive opener is often a long-lasting, budget-conscious option, but it can produce increased vibration and sound. A belt-drive opener normally operates with less noise and may be ideal for an attached garage near bedrooms or living areas. A smart garage door opener can provide app control, activity alerts, scheduling, and compatibility with selected home automation systems.

Before installing an opener, the technician should check that the door moves smoothly by hand and that its springs are properly balanced. An opener is not designed to make up for a heavy, binding, or damaged door. The installation should include adjustment of travel limits, testing of the wall switch and remote control, and confirmation of the safety sensors.
