For residential cabinetry, I spec 90+ CRI basically without exception.

Linear strips with diffusers behave greater like a smooth curtain of light. Within strips, optics differ. A slim beam can scallop a lower back panel, while a much broader beam smooths things out. - Puck lights: Round or rectangular, flush or surface-fastened, % lighting fixtures cast a defined pool. They are superb for accenting unmarried gadgets or for a usual seem in a pitcher door cabinet. Space them thoughtfully, and be cautious of hotspots on reflective surfaces.
- Micro profiles and aspect-lit panels: When you won't be able to recess a channel, a narrow surface profile blends in and provides a easy line of faded. Edge-lit panels, basically tradition sized, produce a uniform glow throughout a returned surface, extraordinary for frosted glass or a shallow niche.
- Backlighting and toe-kick lights: Backlighting works behind a translucent panel for dramatic glow. Toe-kick lighting lower than a base cupboard or the bottom rail of built-in shelving lifts the total piece off the floor visually and doubles as nighttime lighting.
- Integrated hinge or door-activated lighting: For closets, record bays, and utility cupboards in a domestic place of job integrated, a magnetic or hinge change that brings the gentle on when the door opens keeps hands free and wiring practical.

We routed slim channels within the case sides and mounted prime-opacity diffusers so the strips vanished. Shelves have been notched inside the back for low-voltage wires with nylon bushings to shelter the insulation. A triac dimmer on the access controlled the glass uppers separately from below-cabinet assignment lights. The glass had a moderate ripple, which softened the gentle.
