3.3. Understand Odds and Expected Value

When assessing a bet, ask:

- What is the payout relative to the real probability?
- Does the website take a commission (rake) that further wears down EV?

By regularly preferring bets with an EV near no (or positive, when skill-based), the gamer minimizes the long-term benefit of your house.

3.4. Leverage Skill-Based Wagering
