Battles take this a step even more, permitting several players to open the same cases at the same time, with the player who unboxes the highest total value winning all the contents.

4. Coinflip

A traditional 1v1 game of possibility. 2 players wager skins of roughly equal value. The system designates one player as Heads and the other as Tails, then flips a virtual coin. The winner takes the entire pot, minus a small platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the professional scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match wagering is the go-to option. Users wager on expert groups utilizing chances computed by the platform, similar to traditional sportsbooks.
