The true appeal of Crazy Time depends on its four unique perk rounds. When the wheel lands on a bonus segment, taking part gamers are transferred from the primary studio *crazy time free* into an interactive, augmented-reality minigame.

1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sectors on the wheel.
- **How it works:** A coin with a red side and a blue side is turned by a device. Each side is appointed a random multiplier before the flip. Whichever color lands deal with up determines the gamer's payout.
- **Re-flip function:** If the multipliers assigned to the coin are extremely low, the host might set off a "Rescue" re-flip to give gamers an opportunity at much better worths.

2. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **How it works:** Inspired by the conventional Japanese arcade video game, gamers are shown a large wall filled with physical pegs. The host drops a puck from the top, and it bounces down the board until it lands in one of several multiplier zones at the bottom.
- **Double feature:** If the puck lands in a "Double" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the host drops the puck once again for even larger prizes.

3. Money Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.
- **How it works:** This is a shooting gallery-style perk round. A giant screen shows 108 random multipliers concealed behind various carnival symbols (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat). Gamers utilize an on-screen crosshair to aim and shoot at one sign before a countdown timer ends. Once the timer ends, all signs expose their hidden multipliers.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 segment on the wheel.
- **How it works:** The supreme perk round. The host opens a red door leading into a lively, surreal virtual world featuring a massive 64-segment wheel. Players need to select among three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the selected flapper points to is granted. Like Pachinko, this wheel includes "Double" and "Triple" sectors, which can push multipliers up to a staggering 20,000 x.

Popular Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

Because Crazy Time is a game of opportunity governed by RNG and physical likelihood, no technique can ensure an earnings. Nevertheless, gamers typically adopt different techniques based upon their danger tolerance and bankroll management designs.

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:**
 - *Focus:* Betting mostly on numbers 1 and 2, with occasional little cover bets on bonus rounds.
 - *Goal:* To prolong gameplay and lessen quick bankroll deficiency, depending on regular little wins.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - *Focus:* Placing bets exclusively on the 4 reward rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time).

- **The Balanced Approach:**
 - *Focus:* Spreading bets across both numbers and perk segments.
